Barrington High School Athletic Training Room Policies

- **Staff:** Kevin Stalsberg, Mary Leafblad and Sarah Joyce
- **Hours:** The athletic training room is open Mon. – Fri. from 2 pm – 6:30 pm.
- **Injury and Physician Referral Policy:** If your son/daughter is injured in practice or a game they must report it to our BHS athletic trainers. If an athlete sees a physician, for any reason, during their season; it must be reported to the athletic trainers along with a note from the physician releasing them to return to their sport. WITHOUT a note from the physician, the athlete will NOT be allowed to return to their sport, practices, or games. If an athlete is not participating in P.E. due to an injury, he/she may not participate in any athletics, including free play, practice, or games until released by their physician.
- **Concussion Policy:** Most contact or collision sport athlete's should be baseline tested on our neurocognitive test, ImPact. If an athlete is suspected as having a concussion, they will be removed from participation for that day and retested on ImPact the following day. Their recovery will be monitored using ImPact and participation will not be permitted until the athlete has healed.
